

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Project-Based Learning (PBL)

Our PBL term is drawing to a close! What an action-packed term! This week, all three cohorts had their practice rounds and did some slide editing. The middle cohort will also conduct a practice round on Wednesday next week!

On Monday, we'd like to welcome all of the learners from all cohorts to an on-site rehearsal. At 3 p.m., we will begin our rehearsal. This is to reassure our students so that they may confidently showcase their projects. On Monday, we're looking forward to meeting all of the students! Remember to take an ATK test before you come!

Onsite STEM Innovation “NASA Mission Challenge”

Primary Learners

This week, Our Primary-Explorers designed and built the ziplines to transport a large marble safely. LEGO zip line activity is truly the perfect way for kids to look at ordinary items in new ways and invent something different with them.



Middle Learners

On Tuesday, after our Middle-Engineers learned that NASA is looking for creative ideas for launching heavy payloads into orbit which inspired them to designed and built a heavy-rocket from the set of material.

On Thursday, our Middle learners discussed the possible ways to predict a volcano eruption so that human populations near volcanoes can be safely evacuated before an eruption. They worked in groups to build a dam, and test an alarm device to alert people and reduce the impact of volcano eruption.



Virtual STEM Innovation

In the primary section we got to know the 10–20–30-rule of Guy Kawasaki, who is an investor who has to judge many business pitches. In 10 slides, in 20 minutes only using font size larger than 30 points tall. We practiced using speaker notes so we don't read from the slides anymore. These are long term goals which have to be practiced and will not be achieved right away. We introduced a BAFTA awarded cooperation game "Never Walk Alone" in which an Inuit girl and her new found friend a wild young fox fight for survival against the elements.

This week in middle school we introduced basic design principles (Contrast, Balance, Emphasis, Proportion, Hierarchy, Repetition, Rhythm, Pattern, White space, Movement, Variety, Unity), let students experience how vector graphic designs is different from pixel-based designs. We used Google Drawings for the vector-based designs and tasked learners to design a 24x24 pixel--based icon in Minecraft.

Astra Nova Conundrum Session

We dug deep into the Art Conundrum this week. There were four options available. The fundamental dilemma was which artwork should be in the Lakeville Art Museum. The learners made their decisions and investigated the possibilities of the other options. We scaled the pros and cons of having the artwork. We encourage parents to discuss the Conundrums with their children!

This week we had our first sessions of MAP assessments and suffice it to say we learned a lot! Next week, MAP assessments will be on Monday, 29 November for Primary and Secondary cohorts. Our EFL learners will also be coming in on Monday for their class since they are in a separate room. Remember, these assessments are to see how WeLearn is doing, and won't be used to evaluate the learners themselves, so if your kids are getting anxious, please let them know that they should relax and try to do their best.
